1. All passengers must have the MySejahtera app on their phones for contact tracing and entry scanning at shops and restaurants.

7. Shore excursion fares are denominated in MYR.
8. Child fare is applicable to those aged 11 or below. Infants aged below 2 come free.
9. Shore excursion tickets are neither refundable nor transferrable after they have been sold.
10. Shore excursions require a minimum number of participating persons and may be cancelled if there are insufficient participants.
11. All shore excursions are sold on a first-come, first-served basis and have a maximum limit of participating persons. To avoid disappointment, guests are recommended to reserve shore excursions early.
12. Some shore excursions may require long-distance walking. It is recommended that guests should consider their physical conditions before joining such shore excursions.
