The Babas and Nyonyas are the offspring of the Chinese who came from China and intermarried the local ladies. Babas and Nyonyas do not speak Chinese but only English and Malay patios. ▪ <u>Lunch at a popular Nyonya Restaurant</u> - Nyonya cuisine is the cuisine of the Baba Nyonya community. The food is mix of Chinese and Malay cuisine. ▪ <u>Melaka Straits Mosque</u> (outside visit) – the beautiful mosque was built so that when the water tide is at just the right height, the Mosque looks like it is floating on the ocean. ▪ <u>Jonker Street</u> – was once renowned for its antique shops, however over the years it has turned to clothing and crafts outlets as well as restaurants.

Cheng Ho was a famous Chinese explorer, who went to the Middle East, Africa and South East Asia between 1405 and 1433. In one of these voyages he came to Melaka, and he is credited with the honor of discovering the Melaka Port for the Chinese. The museum is filled with artifacts related to the great explorer. There are about 2,000 items of historical importance related to Cheng Ho and the Ming Dynasty on display at the museum, including crockery, coins, the Cheng Ho Well, clothing and a replica of Cheng Ho's ship.
- **Jonker Street** – was once renowned for its antique shops, however over the years it has turned to clothing and crafts outlets as well as restaurants.
