Penang, MALAYSIA

SuperStar Libra will continue to homeport in Penang from now until 8 March 2015. SuperStar Aquarius will replace SuperStar Libra from 8 – 26 March 2015 to homeport in Penang, offering the 4D/3N Phuket/Krabi destination cruise and the 2D/1N High Seas cruise.

SINGAPORE

SuperStar Gemini will continue to homeport in Singapore from now until 29 March 2015. Commencing 30 March 2015, SuperStar Libra will replace SuperStar Gemini to homeport in Singapore, offering the following destination cruise itineraries that include the 4D/3N Penang/Langkawi cruise, 4D/3N Tioman/Redang cruise, 4D/3N Penang/Port Klang cruise, 3D/2N Malacca cruise, 3D/2N Port Klang cruise, as well as the 3D/2N High Seas cruise.
